**EFFORTS TO MAKE INDIA A DEVELOPED NATION BY 2047**

**(a) to (e):** The Ministry of Textiles is implementing various schemes/initiatives to promote the textiles sector and contribute to the vision of India becoming a developed Nation by 2047 and achieving the goal of 'Viksit Bharat'.

The major schemes/initiatives taken by the Ministry include PM Mega Integrated Textile Regions and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks Scheme which seeks to create a modern, integrated, world class textile infrastructure; Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme focusing on MMF Fabric, MMF Apparel and Technical Textiles to boost large scale manufacturing and enhancing competitiveness; National Technical Textiles Mission focusing on Research Innovation & Development, Promotion and Market Development; SAMARTH – Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector with the objective providing demand driven, placement oriented, skilling program; Silk Samagra-2 for comprehensive development of sericulture value chain ; National Handloom Development Program for end to end support for handloom sector; National Handicrafts Development Programme and Comprehensive Handicrafts Cluster Development Scheme for promotion of handicraft artisans.

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
