ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM NIRBHAYA FUND

320#. DR. SUMER SINGH SOLANKI:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the fund allocated by Government to the State of Madhya Pradesh from the Nirbhaya Fund for the year 2024-25;
- (b) the number of vehicle location tracking devices installed by the Madhya Pradesh Transport Department in coordination with the Central and State Governments for the safety of women/girls through this fund;
- (c) the details of State of Madhya Pradesh thereof, district-wise; and
- (d) the location of its Command and Control Center in Madhya Pradesh?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SAVITRI THAKUR)

(a) The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has released an amount of Rs. 45 lakh during the current Financial Year 2024-25 for the Setting up/strengthening Women Help Desks in Police Stations in the state of Madhya Pradesh under Nirbhaya Fund. Further, Ministry of Women and Child Development has released an amount of Rs. 11.21 Crores for One Stop Centres (OSCs) and 0.38 Crore for Women Helpline to Madhya Pradesh during 2024-25. Ministry of Tourism has allocated Rs. 5.27 Cr for the financial year 2024-25 for Safe Tourism Destination for women in Madhya Pradesh. Department of Justice has disbursed Rs 105.96 crore to the state of Madhya Pradesh as Central Share for implementing the Fast Track Courts (FTSCs) Scheme since inception of the scheme in 2019. Ministry of Railways has informed that allocation of Nirbhaya Fund is done project-wise and zonal railway wise. No state-wise data is maintained.

(b) & (c) As per information received from Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MORTH), under the scheme "Development, Customisation, Deployment and Management of State-wise Vehicle Tracking Platform for Safety and Enforcement as per AIS specifications in States /UTs under Nirbhaya Framework" funds are provided to State/UT Governments to establish Monitoring Centres so as to effectively monitor the location & movement of vehicles; Location Tracking Devices (VLTD) have to be installed by the respective vehicle owners.

RTO-wise details of VLT Devices fitted in vehicles in the State of Madhya Pradesh, as per back end application of State of Madhya Pradesh, as on 18 11.2014 are provided in the **Annexure.**

(d) Command and Control Center is located in New RTO Office, Kokta, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.
