MOBILE NETWORK IN ODISHA

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that mobile service connectivity and call drop is very high in interior and rural areas of Odisha particularly in Mayurbhanj;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that BSNL and private mobile service network need to be improvised;
- (c) if so, whether Government has taken such steps to improve the mobile connectivity in rural areas of Odisha particularly in Mayurbhanj;
- (d) if so, the the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of mobile tower installed by Government and private companies in Mayurbhanj and neighboring districts in last three years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (DR. PEMMASANI CHANDRA SEKHAR)

- (a) As per Performance Monitoring Report (PMR) published by Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) for quarter ending Sept-2024, all Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) are meeting the prescribed benchmark for call drop rate in Odisha.
- (b) Telecom Operators including BSNL regularly improve the mobile services by optimizing their existing mobile network.
- (c) & (d) Total 1706 no. of mobile towers in Odisha and 18 no. of mobile towers in Mayurbhanj District have been installed under various schemes initiated by the Government through Digital Bharat Nidhi Scheme (erstwhile USOF) to improve mobile connectivity in uncovered villages of Odisha.
- (e) Total no. of mobile towers installed by Government and Private Companies in the Mayurbhanj and neighboring districts in last three years are as follows –
