CONSERVATION AND MAINTENANCE WORK OF PROTECTED MONUMENTS

354. DR. DHARMASTHALA VEERENDRA HEGGADE

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has taken steps for conservation and maintenance work of protected monuments and sites in the country particularly in Karnataka, especially Bhagwan Bahubali Statue at Shravanabelagola, temples of Halebidu, Hassan and Gol Gumbaz, Bijapur;
- (b) if so, the details thereof till date;
- (c) the names of ancient monuments for which grants are being provided, State-wise; and
- (d) the details of the expenditure incurred on the maintenance of the said monuments during the last three years, State-wise/Circle-wise?

- (a) Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has 3697 monuments/sites under its jurisdiction in to the country including the State of Karnataka. The conservation and preservation of the
- (c) monuments/sites including Bhagwan Bahubali Statue at Shravanabelagola, temples of Halebidu, Hassan and Gol Gumbaz, Bijapur are taken up as per the requirement and availability of resources and they are in good state of preservation. The details are given in Annexure-I.

1.	Hoyasaleshwara temple, Halebidu, Belur Taluk, Hassan District	Shortening of loose fallen stone architectural members at surrounding to Hucheshwara temple at Halebidu.
2.	Amrutheshwara temple, Amruthapura, Tarikere taluk, Hassan district	Pointing to Gopura of the temple to prevent water leakage.
3.	Lakshmidewi temple, Doddagadavali, Hassan taluk, Hassan district	Fixing of new teak wood door and door frames inside the temples of doors.
4.	Ishwara temple, Arsikere, Arsikere taluk, Hassan district	Repairing work of damaged doors at Ishwara temple at Arsikere.
5.	Gomatesvara, Sravanabelgola, Hassan	Reconstruction of Fallen wall at Shravanabelagola
6.	Gol Gumbaz at Vijayapura	Works for providing tourist infrastructure; Comprehensive Conservation work, structural repairs chhajjas, minarets etc. at Gol-Gumbaz.
