(a) to (d): Job fairs are organized as part of National Career Service (NCS) Project under the administrative control of Ministry of Labour & Employment.

As per information available with Ministry of Labour & Employment, 34,809 Job fairs were conducted by State Employment Exchanges/Model Career Centres during the last five years (2019-20 to 2023-24). During this period, 26,83,161 Jobseekers and 83,913 Employers participated in the Job fairs and 24,37,188 candidates have been provisionally shortlisted
