(a) and (b): Capacity building of government officials under "Mission Karmayogi" focuses on enhancing the attitudes, skills and knowledge of government officials through role-based training. This has shifted the training ecosystem from rule-based, supply-driven to role-based, demand-driven capacity building where capacity building is targeted to the competency needed for each role in the government, and the aspirations of each government official.

46 lakh+ users have registered on iGOT Karmayogi Platform, of which more than 10.4 lakh are from all the states/UTs. Through a competency-driven capacity building, Mission Karmayogi has initiated a new culture in governance. A total of 1500+ courses available on the iGOT Karmayogi portal are helping to build behavioural, functional, and domain competencies of civil servants. These course have special focus on making the government employee future-ready and citizen centric.

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
