- (d) the timescale for fully integrating digital and on-site learning to build civil service skills at all levels?

(a) to (d): Yes, assessment has been carried out through feedback collated through surveys and focus group discussions (FGDs) conducted by external agencies which also helps in taking necessary steps for course correction.

90%+ users reported the platform user friendly. The average user rating for the Courses on the Platform is more than 4.3 (on a scale of 5) The platform is regularly updated from time to time based on the collated feedback and surveys.
