Establishment of National Centre of Excellence by SAI

469 Shri Dhananjay Bhimrao Mahadik:

Will the Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Sports Authority of India (SAI) has signed MoU with Government of Maharashtra for the establishment of National Centre of Excellence and if so, the details therof and the time by which it will be established;

(b) the number of stadiums with infrastructure facilities which are operational in the country including Maharashtra; and

(c) the quantum of funds allocated for sports infrastructure development under various Central Government schemes, such as the Khelo India Scheme and the SAI schemes to the State of Maharashtra during the last three years and the current year?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (DR. MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

(a) and (b): Yes, Sir. Sports Authority of India (SAI) and Government of Maharashtra entered into a MoU on 06.10.2024 to facilitate the effective utilization, development and maintenance of the land parcel of approximate 37 acres situated in Akurli Road, Kandivali East, Mumbai for sports related purpose/establishment of a National Centre of Excellence (NCoE). There are five major stadiums under SAI which are operational in the country. The details are given at <u>Annexure</u>.

(c): Under the component "Creation and Up-gradation of Sports Infrastructure" of the Khelo India scheme, 323 sports infrastructure projects of different categories have been sanctioned across the country, including 14 in the State of Maharashtra at a sanctioned cost of Rs. 117.80 crore. The details are available at https://mdsd.kheloindia.gov.in/. Further, under the SAI Sports Promotional Schemes, one project amounting to Rs. 1.98 crore has been sanctioned in the State of Maharashtra during last three years and current year. Under the National Sports Development Fund (NSDF) scheme, two projects amounting to Rs. 1.725 crore have been sanctioned in the State of Maharashtra during the last three year and current year.
