SPORTS DEVELOPMENT IN PUNJAB.

475. SHRI SANT BALBIR SINGH

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:-

- (a) the progress of work under the National Sports Development Fund Scheme and the Pension Scheme for Talented Sportsmen, State-wise particularly in the districts of Punjab;
- (b) the details of the amount sanctioned and allocated to the State of Punjab under the National Sports Development Fund, item-wise and district-wise; and
- (c) the number of meritorious sportspersons who have been given pension in the State of Punjab and the number of applications received and approved, year-wise and district-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS

(a) and (c): The details of the progress of work under the National Sports Development Fund Scheme are attached as per Annexure I. Further, the Government is implementing the Scheme of Pension to Meritorious Sportsperson with an objective to provide assured monthly income through annuity for outstanding sportspersons. Under the existing Scheme, a monthly pension ranging from Rs. 12,000/- to Rs. 20,000/- is provided to the ex-sportspersons. Currently, 879 ex-sportspersons are receiving benefits under the Scheme. State-wise list is not maintained in the Department.

(b): Allocation of funds under National Sports Development Fund is not done state wise. The details of the amount sanctioned to the state of Punjab, item-wise and district-wise; are placed at Annexure-II.
