INDUSTRIAL PARKS IN TELANGANA

524. Shri Damodar Rao Divakonda:

Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any Industrial Parks and large scale commercial industries are being set up in Telangana to boost trade and mitigate unemployment;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether there is a report of Telangana Government's financial progress in terms of commerce/industry since 2023?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) & (b): In addition to initiatives by the State Governments, the Central Government also comes out with initiatives and policies to promote industrialization in various parts of the country.

Under the **National Industrial Corridor Development Programme,** the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister has approved development of Zaheerabad Industrial area in Telangana as part of 12 new industrial project proposals under the National Industrial Corridor Development Programme (NICDP) on 28th August, 2024. The project located in Sangareddy district has an activation area of 3,245 acre with a total project cost of Rs. 2,360 crores. Share of Government of India's contribution (through National Industrial Corridor Development and Implementation Trust) has been approved for Rs. 596 Crore as equity and Rs. 655 Crore towards debt.

Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology under Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC) Scheme & Modified Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC 2.0) Scheme have reported that 97 units have booked manufacturing space with their projected investment of approximately Rs. 17,443 crore and employment generation of 64,282 persons. The detail of these projects in Telanganais placed at Annexure-I. **Ministry of Food Processing Industries** under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) has approved 68 projects for food processing industries in Telangana state with a total project cost of Rs. 1849.12 crores. Out of these, 32 projects have been completed. The details of these projects as on 15.11.2024 are placed at Annexure-II.

Ministry of Textiles is setting up 7 (seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with world class infrastructure including plug and play facility with an outlay of Rs. 4445 cr for a period of seven years upto 2027-28. The Government has finalised 7 sites including one in Warangal, Telangana for setting up PM MITRA Parks. Ministry of Textiles is also implementing Scheme for Integrated Textile Park (SITP) to provide support for setting up Textile Park with world-class, state-of-the art infrastructure in textile hubs across the country. Under SITP, two projects have been sanctioned inTelangana, details of which are placed at Annexure-III.

The detail of industrial parks and large scale industries as reported by Govt. of Telangana is placed at Annexure-IV.
