**STATEMENT** REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 589 BY SHRI SUBHASISH KHUNTIA ANSWERED IN RAJYA SABHA ON 29.11.2024 REGARDING RAILWAY CONNECTIVITY BETWEEN PURI SHREE JAGANNATH DHAM AND OTHER THREE DHAMS

(a) to (c): Puri is already connected to Rameshwaram and Dwarka through Broad Gauge route on Indian Railway network.

Badrinath Dham falls in high altitude Himalyas and presently it can be reached by road from Haridwar/ Rishikesh. Haridwar is well connected to major cities of India including Puri through railway network. Further, to improve rail connectivity in higher regions of Uttarakhand, Indian Railways has taken up challenging work of construction of New Line from Rishikesh to Karnprayag in very difficult terrain of young Himalyas.

The new Railway line project from Rishikesh to Karnprayag (125 Km) involves construction of 105 Km tunnels, out of which about 89 Km tunneling has been completed. The works are progressing at a fast pace and stack up to best international standards.
