AIRPORTS SOLD/LEASED OUT TO PRIVATE COMPANIES

668. SHRI JAVED ALI KHAN

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of airports sold/ leased out to private companies since January 2019 till November, 2024 alongwith the names of private companies to whom these airports have been handed over, airport-wise;
- (b) the details of revenue generated by selling/ leasing out airports and services therein since 2019 till date, airport-wise;
- (c) the details of airports which are still fully under Government; and
- (d) the details of airports which Government has proposed to sell/lease out to private companies during 2024-25 and 2025-26?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Shri Murlidhar Mohol)

- (a): Since 2019, Airports Authority of India (AAI) has leased out six of its airports at Lucknow, Ahmedabad, Mangaluru, Jaipur, Guwahati and Thiruvananthapuram for better operations, management and development of these airports under Public Private Partnership (PPP) for a lease period of 50 years, where the ownership of these leased airports remains with AAI. The details of companies that currently run these airports are as under:
- (1) Chaudhary Charan Singh International Airport, Lucknow M/s Lucknow International Airport Limited (LIAL)
- (2) Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport, Ahmedabad M/s Ahmedabad International Airport Limited (AIAL)

- (3) Mangaluru International Airport M/s Mangaluru International Airport Limited (MaIAL)
- (4) Jaipur International Airport M/s Jaipur International Airport Limited (JIAL)
- (5) Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport, Guwahati M/s Guwahati International Airport Limited (GIAL)
- (6) Thiruvananthapuram International Airport M/s TRV-Kerala International Airport Limited (TIAL)
- (b): Since handing over, the Private Partners of these six airports have paid approximately Rs. 2310 crore to AAI in the form of Per Passenger Fee (PPF) till October, 2024. AAI has also received an amount of approximately Rs. 5260 crore from the Private Partners of these six airports in the form of upfront fee towards the capital expenditure incurred by AAI at these airports.
- (c): List of 102 operational airports of AAI is enclosed at Annexure.
- (d): As per National Monetisation Pipeline (NMP), 25 Airports of Airports Authority of India (AAI) namely, Bhubaneswar, Varanasi, Amritsar, Trichy, Indore, Raipur, Calicut, Coimbatore, Nagpur, Patna, Madurai, Surat, Ranchi, Jodhpur, Chennai, Vijayawada, Vadodara, Bhopal, Tirupati, Hubli, Imphal, Agartala, Udaipur, Dehradun and Rajahmundry have been earmarked for leasing over the years 2022 to 2025.
