STATUS OF PMAY (U) IN TAMIL NADU

700. SHRI M. MOHAMED ABDULLA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and the current status of various works being carried out under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) in the State of Tamil Nadu, district-wise;
- (b) the details of central funds allocated and utilized in this regard and the number of beneficiaries till date during the last three years; and
- (c) whether projects for in-situ slum rehabilitation have been incentivized under urban planning reforms and if so the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) & (b): 'Land' and 'Colonization' are State subjects. Therefore, schemes related to housing for their citizens are implemented by States/Union Territories (UTs). However, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs supplements the efforts of States/UTs by providing Central assistance under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana- Urban (PMAY-U) since 25.06.2015 to provide pucca houses with basic civic amenities to all eligible urban beneficiaries across the country including the slum dwellers. The scheme is implemented through four verticals i.e. Beneficiary-Led Construction (BLC), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), In-Situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) and Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS). As on 25.11.2024, 6.80 lakh houses have been sanctioned by the Ministry for Tamil Nadu under PMAY-U, out of which 6.65 lakh have been grounded and 5.87 lakh have been completed / delivered to the beneficiaries. Central Assistance of Rs.11,185.30 crore has been sanctioned for construction of these houses out of which Rs.10,188.58 crore has been released to the State / Central Nodal Agencies (CNA). The Scheme has been extended till 31.12.2024, except for CLSS vertical of the scheme, to complete all the houses sanctioned without changing the funding pattern and implementation methodology.

During the last three years (FY 2021-24), Central Assistance of Rs.3,178.62 crore were released and utilized, and 1.20 lakh houses were sanctioned out of which 81,537 were completed/delivered. Additionally, 94,958 houses sanctioned in the years preceding to the last three years were also completed.

District-wise details of houses sanctioned, grounded, and completed along with Central Assistance sanctioned and released since inception for the State of Tamil Nadu under PMAY-U are at Annexure.

(c) In-Situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) component of PMAY-U is specifically for redevelopment of slum using land as a resource for providing houses to eligible slum dwellers. Under ISSR, slum rehabilitation grant of Rs. 1 lakh per house for redevelopment of slums is provided. As on 25.11.2024, 4,763 houses have been sanctioned under ISSR vertical of PMAY-U for Tamil Nadu. All houses have been completed/delivered to the beneficiaries.
