- (a) The Ministry of Ayush is implementing a Central Sector Scheme namely AYURSWASTHYA Yojana, since FY 2021-22. The Scheme has 02 components viz. (i) Ayush and Public Health (ii) Centre of Excellence (CoE). Under the Scheme, the funds are not allocated State/UT-wise. Further, the details of individual organizations and institutions receiving financial assistance under AYURSWASTHYA Scheme including Maharashtra are enclosed at **Annexure.**
- (b) This Ministry has not conducted any impact study/assessment till date to monitor the impact of financial assistance provided to organizations under AYURSWASTHYA Scheme on public health outcomes.
