**IMPLEMENTATION OF AB-PMJAY**

**910. SHRI SANJAY SINGH:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken to remove bottlenecks in registration and claim processes under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana, (AB-PMJAY);
- (b) the details of number of patients registered and amount spent for treatment under the said scheme in the last three years, year-wise and State-wise; and
- (c) whether any cases of financial irregularities and fraud have been registered in the said scheme in the last three years, if so, the details of registered cases, year-wise and State-wise?

(a) to (c): Under Ayushman Bharat- Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY), enrolment of beneficiaries is application-based, allowing beneficiaries to apply for and obtain their Ayushman card. Different modes of application are available for enrolment in the scheme including mobile phone application (Ayushman App) and web portal (beneficiary.nha.gov.in). Further, to make the enrolment process easy, a feature of self-registration is also available in the above-mentioned application.

Timely settlement of claims is one the key parameters against which the scheme performance is measured. The status of claim settlement under the scheme is constantly monitored and review meetings are organized regularly to take stock of the progress with regards to the claims. Green Channel Payments (GCP) has been launched with the objective to ensure timely payment to the hospitals. Under GCP, partial payment of 50% of the claim amount is automatically released to the hospitals at the time of claim submission, while the balance is released after the normal claim adjudication process.
