**WATER SHORTAGES IN MANY AREAS**

95 SMT. SAGARIKA GHOSE:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of the Har Ghar Nal Se Jal (HGNSJ) Scheme;
- (b) the number of places in the country that do not have access to adequate water supply;
- (c) the districts which are facing acute water shortages in the country; and
- (d) the funds allocated made to ensure that water supply is maintained?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household. At the start of Jal Jeevan Mission in August 2019, only 3.23 Crore (16.8%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. So far, as reported by States/ UTs as on 20.11.2024, under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal, 12.06 Crore additional rural households have been provided with tap water connections. Thus, as on 20.11.2024, out of 19.34 Crore rural households in the country, around 15.29 Crore (79.04%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes.

As on date, 11 States/ UTs have become ‘Har Ghar Jal’ States/ UT i.e. 100% households are having tap water supply and the remaining States/ UTs are at various stages of achieving the objectives of the mission. State/ UT-wise details of tap water connections as on 20.11.2024 are **annexed**. Further, the district-wise and village-wise status of tap water connection provided under the Mission in rural areas is also in public domain and available on JJM dashboard at:

(d) An amount of Rs.70,162.90 Crore, as Gross Budgetary Support (GBS), has been allocated for implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission in 2024-25.
