REVISION OF INCOME CEILING FOR OBC RESERVATIONS (CREAMY LAYER)

- (a) the details of Government's present initiatives on increase in 'income ceiling' for 27 per cent OBC quotas, which is pending for the last three years;
- (b) whether it is supposed to be revised every three years to adjust for inflation, The 'creamy layer', being last revised from ₹ 6 lakh to ₹ 8 lakh in 2017;
- (c) Government's consideration on the revising the income ceiling for OBCs;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

The revision of income limits is done on an ongoing basis from time to time. The last order for raising the annual income limit from Rs. 6 lakh to Rs. 8 lakh for determining the creamy layer status was issued by Department of Personnel and Training (DoP&T) on 13.9.2017. At present there is no proposal for revision of the income limit.
