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## STATEMENT

**Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) & (b) of the Rajya Sabha Starred Question No. 30 to be answered on 04.02.2025 regarding 'Reverse Auctions conducted for renewable projects' asked by Smt. Sumitra Balmik**

(a) As per the information provided by the Renewable Energy Implementing Agencies (REIAs) of the Ministry of New & Renewable Energy, namely, Solar Energy Corporation of India Limited (SECI), NTPC Limited, NHPC Limited, and SJVN Limited, total 16 reverse auctions were conducted during 2023-24 and 24 reverse auctions have been conducted during 2024-25 (till 31.12.2024), by the REIAs in respect of the bids issued on or after 01.04.2023 for renewable energy (RE) projects.

(b) The range of tariffs discovered for different RE projects under these reverse auctions have been in the range of Rs.2.52 – 5.60 per unit during 2023-24 and Rs.2.48 – 4.99 per unit during 2024-25.

The tariff range has come down from Rs. 5.50- 9.50 per unit in 2013-14 to Rs. 2.48- 4.99 per unit during 2024-25 i.e. a reduction of about 50%

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
