- (a) the number of reverse auctions conducted for renewable energy projects in 2024; and
- (b) the average reduction in tariff, if any, achieved through these auctions compared to the previous year?

STATEMENT

Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) & (b) of the Rajya Sabha Starred Question No. 30 to be answered on 04.02.2025 regarding 'Reverse Auctions conducted for renewable projects' asked by Smt. Sumitra Balmik

- (a) As per the information provided by the Renewable Energy Implementing Agencies (REIAs) of the Ministry of New & Renewable Energy, namely, Solar Energy Corporation of India Limited (SECI), NTPC Limited, NHPC Limited, and SJVN Limited, total 16 reverse auctions were conducted during 2023-24 and 24 reverse auctions have been conducted during 2024-25 (till 31.12.2024), by the REIAs in respect of the bids issued on or after 01.04.2023 for renewable energy (RE) projects.
- (b) The range of tariffs discovered for different RE projects under these reverse auctions have been in the range of Rs.2.52 5.60 per unit during 2023-24 and Rs.2.48 4.99 per unit during 2024-25.

The tariff range has come down from Rs. 5.50- 9.50 per unit in 2013-14 to Rs. 2.48-4.99 per unit during 2024-25 i.e. a reduction of about 50%
