Human-animal conflict

1005. DR. V. SIVADASAN:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has noted the increasing number of wild animals in Schedule 1 and 2 list of Wild Life Protection Act, 1972;
- (b) the number of elephants, tigers, leopards and wild boars in the country since 2020, year-wise and State-wise; and
- (c) whether the State Governments have any power to amend the standard operating procedure to be followed in the capture or killing of animals in Schedule 1 of the Wild Life Protection Act, 1972?

- (a) and (b) The conservation efforts taken over the years have led to increase in the population of several species of wild animals such as tigers, leopards, lions etc.

The details of tiger and leopard population estimation in the country for the year 2022 are at **Annexure-1** and **Annexure-2** respectively. The population estimates of Elephants were last published by the Ministry for the year 2017. The details of population estimates of wild pigs are not collated at the level of the Ministry.

- (c) Hunting of wild animals may be permitted by the Chief Wild Life Wardens of the respective States only in accordance with the provisions of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.
