DEVELOPMENT OF INTERNATIONAL TOURISM IN THE COUNTRY

1096 SHRI R. GIRIRAJAN:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Government has taken any initiative to support and fund State Governments to develop infrastructure facilities in internationally reputed tourist spots in the country, particularly in Tamil Nadu, if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the funds allocated to Tamil Nadu in the last five years for the infrastructure development of tourist spots attracting more international and domestic tourists?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(a) to (b): Development of tourism is primarily undertaken by the concerned State Government/UT Administrations. However, the Ministry of Tourism under its Swadesh Darshan Scheme (SDS) and 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' Schemes provides financial assistance to them for undertaking tourism related projects. Such assistance is provided on receipt of the project proposals from the concerned State Governments/UT Administrations and subject to its adherence to the scheme guidelines and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, availability of budget, inter-se priority etc.

Now the Ministry has revamped the Swadesh Darshan Scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable destinations in the country.

The details of the projects sanctioned under the Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and SD 2.0 schemes in the State of Tamil Nadu is Annexed.

The Ministry of Tourism under Challenge Based Destination Development, a sub-scheme of Swadesh Darshan Scheme has identified 42 destinations in the country for development including 'Thanjavur' (Culture & Heritage category) and 'Rameswaram Island' (Spiritual Category) in the State of Tamil Nadu.

Government of India under its 'Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment (SASCI) -Development of Iconic Tourist Centres to Global Scale' Scheme, sanctioned 40 projects in 23 States for ₹ 3295.76 Crore in Financial Year 2024-25; including the following projects in Tamil Nadu:
