**TOURISM PROJECTS IN MAHARASHTRA**

1098 DR. FAUZIA KHAN:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and number of tourism destinations developed in Maharashtra over the last three years, district-wise;
- (b) the major tourism projects proposed in Maharashtra since 2020, their current status, and the details of ongoing work;
- (c) the number of pending proposals from State Government of Maharashtra with the Central Government, along with reasons for delay; and
- (d) the steps taken to expedite tourism projects and resolve pending proposals?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a) to (d): Development of tourism is primarily undertaken by the concerned State Governments/UT Administrations. However, the Ministry of Tourism under its Swadesh Darshan Scheme (SDS) and Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) Scheme provides financial assistance to them for undertaking tourism related projects. Now the Ministry has revamped the Swadesh Darshan Scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable destinations. Considering projects for sanctioning under the above Schemes is an ongoing process. Such assistance is provided on receipt of the project proposals from the concerned State Governments/UT Administrations and subject to its adherence to the scheme guidelines and instructions issued by the Government, availability of budget, inter-se priority etc. The details of the projects sanctioned under the Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and SD 2.0 schemes in the State of Maharashtra is Annexed.

In addition to Swadesh Darshan Scheme, the Ministry of Tourism under Challenge Based Destination Development, a sub-scheme of Swadesh Darshan Scheme has identified 42 destinations in the country including 'Ahmednagar' under the Culture & Heritage Destinations category in the State of Maharashtra.

Further, Ministry of Tourism regularly undertakes review meetings with the State Governments at different levels to expedite sanctioned tourism projects and resolve pending proposals.

Government of India under its 'Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment (SASCI) – Development of Iconic Tourist Centres to Global Scale' Scheme, sanctioned 40 projects in 23 States for ₹3295.76 Crore in the country including the following projects in the State of Maharashtra, in Financial Year 2024-25:
