(a): Yes Madam, there has been a continuous increase in the all India production of coal, the quantity of Coal produced in the country. The details for the last three years is given below:

2021-22	778.21
2022-23	893.19
2023-24	997.83
2024-25 (Upto February, 2025)	929.15*

(b): Details of consumption of Coal in the country during the last three years are given below:

(Quantity in MT)

Year	2021-22	2022-23	2023-24
Total Domestic Coal Supply (a)	819.21	877.37	973.01
Total Import (b)	208.63	237.67	264.53
Total Consumption / Demand (a+b)	1027.84	1115.04	1237.54
