### STATUS OF DELHI-MEERUT RRTS

#### 1165. DR. LAXMIKANT BAJPAYEE:

### Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of Delhi-Meerut RRTS Corridor, the section of the corridor which has been made operational and the quantum of work pending on the remaining portion along with the time by when the remaining portion will be completed;
- (b) the original plan and timeline for its completion along with the reasons for its delay; and
- (c) the plan made and the measures being taken by Government for its timely and early completion?

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) to (c): At present, 55 Km out of 82.15 Km of Sarai Kale Khan - Modipuram RRTS corridor from New Ashok Nagar to Meerut South is under operation. The physical and financial progress as on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2025 of the said corridor is 82.5% and 78.41% respectively. As per Sanction condition Sarai Kale Khan - Modipuram RRTS corridor to be completed in six years from the date of start of work i.e. June 2019., There is no delay in the timeline for completion of the said project.
