DEVELOPMENT OF SMART CITIES

1184. DR. M. THAMBIDURAI:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has announced Smart City Projects in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, including the cities that were picked up under this project in the State of Tamil Nadu;
- (c) the details of the action plan for the development of Smart Cities in the state during the last five years;
- (d) the details of the funds allocated for the development of Smart Cities during the said period, State-wise, particularly in Tamil Nadu.

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS
(SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

- (a) & (b) Smart Cities Mission (SCM) was launched on 25.06.2015 wherein 100 cities have been selected across the country including 11 Cities viz. Chennai, Coimbatore, Erode, Madurai, Salem, Thanjavur, Thoothukudi, Tiruchirappalli, Tirunelveli, Tiruppur and Vellore in the State of Tamil Nadu.
- (c) As on 04.03.2025, 717 projects amounting to ₹17,626 crore have been completed under SCM in the State of Tamil Nadu. The city-wise details of projects in the State of Tamil Nadu are at Annexure-I. Cities under SCM are being developed based on Smart City Proposals (SCPs), approved by High Powered Steering Committee (HPSC), received from States/UTs including 11 Smart Cities of Tamil Nadu.
- (d) The Central Government has a total outlay of ₹48,000 crore for the 100 cities under SCM. As on 04.03.2025, the cities are able to claim central financial assistance amounting to ₹47,538 crore under SCM, out of which ₹45,772 crore have been utilized. 11 smart cities in the State of Tamil Nadu are able to claim central financial assistance amounting to ₹5,504 crore, out of which ₹5,423 crore have been utilized. The State/City wise details of central financial assistance claimed by all 100 smart cities are at Annexure-II.
