JAL JEEVAN MISSION PROGRAMME IN MADHYA PRADESH

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of schemes approved in the State of Madhya Pradesh under the Central Government's Jal Jeevan Mission programme by the year 2024-25;
- (b) the total amount sanctioned for the State under the said mission and the quantum of funds released to the State so far along with the funds yet to be disbursed;
- (c) by when the outstanding funds would be disbursed by the Central Government to the State under the said mission; and
- (d) the number of households provided with clean piped water in the State under the said mission and the number of households yet to be provided with clean piped water?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI V. SOMANNA)

- (a): Government of India in partnership with States, *inter alia* including the State of Madhya Pradesh, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) Har Ghar Jal to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household. As reported by the State of Madhya Pradesh, 46,423 schemes have been taken up under Jal Jeevan Mission.
- (b) & (c): The initial estimated outlay of the Mission was Rs. 3.60 lakh Crore, out of which Central share was Rs. 2.08 lakh Crore. Almost entire Central share approved by the Cabinet has been released to the eligible States. Further, Hon'ble Finance Minister during her budget speech 2025- 26 has announced extension of Jal Jeevan Mission until 2028 with an enhanced total outlay. The year-wise details of Central fund allocated and fund drawn by the State of Madhya Pradesh under JJM, are as under:

(d): At the start of Jal Jeevan Mission in August 2019, only 13.53 lakh (12.10%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections in the State of Madhya Pradesh. So far, as reported by the State as on 06.03.2025, under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal around 62.35 lakh additional rural households have been provided with tap water connections. Thus, as on 06.03.2025, out of 111.82 lakh rural households in the State, around 75.88 lakh (67.86%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes and works for the remaining 35.94 lakh households are at various stages of completion as per saturation plan of the State.
