BUDGET ALLOCATION FOR EDUCATION

1473 Shri Ryaga Krishnaiah:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of budget allocation for primary, secondary and higher education during 2023-24 and 2024-25, State-wise and year-wise;
- (b) the details of fund released and utilised for primary, secondary and higher education during 2023-24 and 2024-25, year-wise and State-wise; and
- (c) the details of fund allocated for primary, secondary and higher education for the Financial Year 2024-25, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

(a) to (c): Following Centrally Sponsored Schemes are being implemented by the Department of School Education & Literacy under which financial assistance/Central share is provided to the States/UTs for implementation of various interventions.

- (i) The Department of School Education and Literacy is implementing an Integrated Centrally Sponsored Scheme for School Education - **Samagra Shiksha** w.e.f. 2018-19. The scheme aims to ensure that all children, from pre-school to class 12, have access to quality education with an equitable and inclusive classroom environment which should take care of their diverse background, multilingual needs, different academic abilities and make them active participants in the learning process. The scheme aligns with the National Education Policy 2020 and Sustainable Development Goal (SDG-4) which focuses on quality education. The State wise details of funds allocated and Central Share released under Samagra Shiksha for the year 2023-24 and 2024-25 is at Annexure-I.
- (ii) **Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN)** is one of the foremost rights based Centrally Sponsored Scheme implemented in partnership with the States and UTs for providing one hot cooked meal to children studying in Balvatika (pre-primary classes) and classes I to VIII of Government and Government-aided schools on all school days. The State wise details of funds allocated and Central Share released under PM-POSHAN for the year 2023-24 and 2024-25 is at Annexure-II.

- (iii) **The Pradhan Mantri Schools for Rising India (PM-SHRI)**, a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, is being implemented by the Department and has been approved for a period of 5 years w.e.f. 2022-23 to 2026-27. Under the scheme there is provision of setting up of more than 14500 PM SHRI Schools (PM Schools for Rising India) by strengthening the existing schools from amongst schools managed by Central government/State/UT Government/local bodies. The State wise details of funds allocated and Central Share released under PM SHRI for the year 2023-24 and 2024-25 is at Annexure-III.
- (iv) **Strengthening Teaching-Learning and Results for States (STARS) Project**, supported by the World Bank, is being implemented as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) in six States namely Himachal Pradesh, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha and Rajasthan over a period of 5 years, i.e., from F.Y. 2020-21 to F.Y. 2024-25 and aims at improving the assessment system in schools and ensuring equal education for all. STARS Project supplements the efforts of Samagra Shiksha scheme for the school education sector. It encompasses teachers and students from pre-primary to 12th standard as beneficiaries. The State-wise details of funds allocated and Central Share released under STARS for the year 2023-24 and 2024-25 is as given below:

- (v) The Department of Higher Education has launched the third phase of Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) as Pradhan Mantri Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (PM-USHA) in June 2023 with an outlay of Rs. 12926.10 crore for the period 2023-24 to 2025-26 to cater to needs of educationally unserved/ underserved areas. It is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme aimed at funding specific State government universities and colleges, including in the rural areas, so as to improve their quality by ensuring their conformity to prescribed norms and standards. Under Pradhan Mantri Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan, prior to FY 2024-25 provision of State/UT-wise budget allocation was not there. The State wise details of funds allocated and Central Share released under PM-USHA (erstwhile RUSA) for the year 2024-25 is at Annexure-IV.
