**BHARATMALA PARIYOJANA**

1554. MS. INDU BALA GOSWAMI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of corridors proposed to be developed under Bharatmala Pariyojana across the country;
- (b) if so, the number of greenfield high-speed corridors planned to be built under Bharatmala Pariyojana; and
- (c) the expenditure incurred on Bharatmala Pariyojana so far?

**ANSWER**

(a) and (b) Bharatmala Pariyojana was approved by Government of India in 2017 covering a length of 34,800 km across the country. As on 28.02.2025, projects covering a total length of 26,425 km have been awarded and out of this, 19,826 km have already been constructed including Greenfield high-speed corridors. Sanctions under the Bharatmala Pariyojana were halted with effect from 16.11.2023.

(c) The total Expenditure incurred under Bharatmala Pariyojana amounts to Rs. 4,92,562 crore as on 28.02.2025.
