FOUR-LANE HIGHWAY CONNECTIVITY TO COASTAL DISTRICTS OF ODISHA

1556. SHRI MANAS RANJAN MANGARAJ:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government has proposed to develop four-lane highways connecting major coastal districts of Odisha to promote tourism and trade;
- (b) if so, the details of these proposed highways, including project costs, funding sources and timelines;
- (c) the current status of land acquisition and approvals for these projects; and
- (d) the measures being taken to ensure timely execution of these highway projects?

(a) to (d) The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the development of the Coastal Highway via Puri, Kakatpur, Paradeep, Ratanpur, Chandipur, and Digha, with a tentative length of 408.435 km, has been awarded. The scope of DPR includes alignment study, feasibility study, and preconstruction activities (including land acquisition assessment).

The award of civil construction work shall be taken up after the completion of DPR, statutory clearances and pre-construction activities depending upon projected traffic, techno economic viability and inter-se-priority. It is premature to indicate the cost of project and completion time.
