Will the Minister of SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) the number of State Governments which have already implemented separate science policy in their respective States;

(b) the first State in the country that has implemented science policy after independence; and

(c) the expected date of the new science and technology policy by the Union Government?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY & EARTH SCIENCES (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) The State Governments of Kerala (1974 & 2002), Gujarat (2018), Himachal Pradesh (2021) and Madhya Pradesh (2022) have already implemented separate science policy in their respective States.

(b) Kerala was the first state that implemented the science and technology policy after independence in 1974.

(c) At present, no new science and technology policy is under consideration by the Union Government.
