CONSTRUCTION OF YOUTH HOSTELS

1756 # SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether youth hostels have been built in major cities across various States of the country;
- (b) if so, the details along with names of the cities, State-wise;
- (c) the criteria fixed for selecting sites for the construction of youth hostels; and
- (d) the number of places where the construction of youth hostels is going on along with the total number of new hostels proposed, the details thereof, State-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS

(DR. MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

- (a) & (b) A total 84 Youth Hostels have been constructed under the Youth Hostel sub-scheme across various States/ UTs of the country. The State/UT-wise list, along with name of the cities, of the Youth Hostels constructed so far, is at Annexure.
- (c) Youth Hostels are a joint venture of the Central and State Governments. Selection of place for construction of a Youth Hostel is done as per the provisions of Youth Hostel Manual. The following considerations decide the selection of a place:
 - (i) Historical and cultural value;
 - (ii) Educational centre, State capital;
 - (iii) Place of tourist importance, scenic beauty and hill station;
 - (iv) Place which offers facilities for Youth activities; and
 - (v) Port of entry.

The State/UT Government is required to make available a suitable plot with 1.5 to 2 acres or more area free of cost for construction of the Youth Hostel. However, in case of State Capitals, big Cities and hilly areas a fully developed plot of land measuring 0.75 to 1 acre may be considered as

acceptable for the construction of Youth Hostel building. It must be a developed plot, with an approach road and a boundary wall and with adequate water facilities and electric supply. The following points are kept in view while selecting the site:-

- (i) Adequate water supply throughout the year;
- (ii) Proximity to the centre of communication from the Railway Station or Central Bus Stand and cheap mode of public or private conveyance is easily available;
- (iii) Good approach road or nearness to a public highway. Groups traveling by buses should be able to reach the Hostel without difficulty and there must be parking facilities for the buses;
- (iv) As far as possible near to marketing area, shopping centres, restaurants, Posts and Telegraphs Office and facility of Telephone, medical centre and Bank
- (v) Good sewerage system and electric supply; and
- (vi) Located in quiet surroundings. Slightly isolated place will be advantageous.
- (d) A new Youth Hostel is under construction at Kota, Rajasthan. No other new Youth Hostels are proposed for construction.
