- (a) to (c): The objective of starting Alliance Air is to provide connectivity to Tier II and Tier III cities in India. Alliance Air is 100% owned subsidiary of AI Assets Holding Limited, Government of India owned company.
- (d) At present, Alliance Air has 996 employees and all are Fixed Term Contractual staff.
- (e) Alliance Air has 21 no. of Airplanes (20 ATR and 1 Dornier). Out of the same, 10 aircraft are operational as of now and others are awaiting repair due to supply chain issue.
