**Jan Aushadhi Kendras in Maharashtra**

**177 Shri Ashokrao Shankarrao Chavan:**

Will the Minister of **Chemicals and Fertilizers** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Jan Aushadhi Kendras (JAKs) established under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) in Maharashtra, district-wise, particularly in Nanded district during each of the last three years and current year;
- (b) the number of beneficiaries of JAK during the said period, district-wise;
- (c) the details of funds allocated and disbursed for the establishment and operation of Jan Aushadhi Kendras in Maharashtra, district-wise; and
- (d) the impact of Jan Aushadhi Kendras on healthcare affordability and access in Nanded district?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS**

**(SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)**

(a): Under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana scheme, a total of 707 Jan Aushadhi Kendras have been opened in the State of Maharashtra. District-wise list of Kendras opened in the State is at **Annexure**.

A total of eight Jan Aushadhi Kendras have been opened in Nanded district of Maharashtra during the period of three financial years consisting of the current financial year and the preceding two financial years. Details of the same are as under:

(b): It is estimated that about 10 to 12 lakh consumers buy medicines daily from Jan Aushadhi Kendras across the country.

(c): There is no State- or Union-territory-wise budget allocation under the scheme.

(d): In the last 10 years, sales of medicines worth ₹6,462 crore have been made through Jan Aushadhi Kendras, which has resulted in estimated savings of about ₹30,000 crore to citizens as compared to branded medicines. In Maharashtra, since the financial year 2018-2019, sales of medicines worth ₹92 crore have been made, which has resulted in estimated savings of about ₹460 crore.
