- (a) the reasons for the reduction in allocation of funds from ₹1150.02 Cr in BE 2024-25 to ₹108.70 Cr in RE 2024-25 and the details thereof;
- (b) the status of adoption and implementation of modules offered through the UPYOG portal by cities and towns and the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the adoption of modules under the UPYOG portal has contributed to improved ease of doing business and ease of living for citizens and the details thereof?

- (a) to (c) The Scheme of National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM) for the period 2025-29 is under consideration. Keeping in view of the fast end of the current financial year and in pursuance of the fund flow guidelines of Ministry of Finance, the fund at Revised Estimate stage was requested to be reduced to ₹108.70 crore in 2024-25. The central financial assistance for digitalizing of the urban services in 22 States/ UTs through the Urban Platform for Delivery of Online Governance (UPYOG) Portal will be released upon approval and roll out of the scheme.
