- (a) the number of pilgrims who have gone to Haj during the last three years;
- (b) whether number of pilgrims visiting Haj have decreased since the abolishment of subsidy; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

(a): The details of India's Haj quota and number of pilgrims proceeded for Haj during the last three years, is as follows:-

(b) and (c): The number of pilgrims proceeding for Haj has not decreased since the abolishment of Haj subsidy. Haj Committee of India has fully utilised the Haj quota allocated to it every year w.e.f. Haj 2018, (the year when the Haj subsidy was completely withdrawn). In year 2017, only 1,70,025 pilgrims proceeded for Haj, which has increased since then, as per (a) above.
