# **DEATHS DUE TO HEPATITIS-B IN THE COUNTRY**

#### Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that deaths due to Hepatitis-B are increasing in the country every year;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of death cases reported in the country during the last five years, year-wise and State-wise; and

(c) the steps taken/ proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) & (b) The details of the number of deaths cases reported in the country due to Hepatitis-B during last five years, year-wise and state-wise are placed at **Annexure**.

(c) The Government of India (GoI) has launched the National Viral Hepatitis Control Program (NVHCP) in 2018 under the aegis of National Health Mission (NHM), offering diagnostic and treatment services for Hepatitis C, A and E. The scope of the program was expanded to include diagnosis and management of Hepatitis B in 2019. Hepatitis B is a vaccine preventable disease and the program provides for administration of Hepatitis B birth dose vaccine & Hepatitis B Immunoglobulin to the babies born to Hepatitis B positive mothers.

The NVHCP envisages prevention of viral Hepatitis through awareness generation and behaviour change communication. All diagnostic and treatment services are provided free of cost under NVHCP at the designated Government Health Facilities.
