**STATUS OF NEW GREENFIELD AIRPORT IN PARANDUR, TAMIL
NADU**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) details of the present status of new Greenfield airport in Parandur, Tamil Nadu;
- (b) whether it is a fact that the local villagers from whom lands are proposed to be acquired are not happy with the compensation being decided;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) steps taken by Government to compensate the poor villagers?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): In August, 2024, Government of India has granted Site Clearance approval to Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation Limited (TIDCO), a Government of Tamil Nadu Enterprise for development of Greenfield Airport at Parandur, Tamil Nadu. In September, 2024, application for grant of 'In-Principle' approval along with Detailed Project Report & other requisite documents have been received from TIDCO.

As per the Greenfield Airports Policy, 2008, the responsibility for implementation of the Greenfield airport project including land acquisition, funding, R&R etc. lies with the concerned airport developer or the State Government, as the case may be.
