SRIBHUMI, ASSAM**

- (a) the steps taken for setting up of a skill development and entrepreneurship training centre in Sribhumi district of Assam for imparting training of new trades there; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and, if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) and (b): Under the Government of India's Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society across the country including the Sribhumi district of Assam. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready, equipped with industry relevant skills.

The schemes of MSDE for skill development are demand driven and the training centres (TCs) are set up/engaged on need basis to impart the training across the country. Details of training centres under schemes of MSDE at the pan India level and in Assam and Sribhumi District are given below:
