BHARATNET PROJECT IN PUNJAB

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Gram Panchayats of Punjab covered under BharatNet project;
- (b) the details of progress made under different phases of BharatNet project against deadlines;
- (c) the progress of BharatNet project in the State of Punjab during last five years; and
- (d) the reasons as to why the BharatNet project has been missing back to back deadlines?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (DR. PEMMASANI CHANDRA SEKHAR)

(a) to (d) BharatNet is being implemented in a phased manner to provide broadband connectivity to all the Gram Panchayats (GPs) in the country, including Punjab. Out of total 13,337 GPs in Punjab, 12,668 GPs (7,951 in Phase-I and 4,717 GPs in Phase-II) were planned under BharatNet Phase-I and Phase-II, and all have been made service ready. The remaining GPs of the state and further strengthening of the network is under the scope of Amended BharatNet Program.
