ACUTE SHORTAGE OF EXECUTIVE ENGINEERS IN ESIC

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government intends to revise the sanctioned posts of Executive Engineer (Electrical) in Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) to meet the growing demand and ensure proper maintenance and safety of the institutions it runs;
- (b) if so, the proposed timeline by which such posts will be revised; and
- (c) if not, the reasons for not addressing this critical shortage that directly impacts patient safety and the operational efficiency of its institutions?
