**EXTENSION ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT BY KVKs**

2426. MS. DOLA SEN:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) established and functioning, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the number of farmer training and field demonstrations conducted by the KVKs, in the last three years, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the number of farm science clubs created for inducting younger generations of farming families into the sector;
- (d) the details of major extension activities carried out by KVKs nationwide along with the number of participants/beneficiaries under each activity; and
- (e) whether Government is planning to replicate the Rythu Bharosa Kendram model at the national scale, if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

- (a): In all, 731 Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) have been established in the country. State/UT-wise total number of KVKs established till date is given in **Annexure-I**.
- (b): The KVKs trained 58.01 lakh farmers and conducted 8.69 lakh frontline demonstrations on the new technologies of agriculture and allied sectors during last 3 years (2021-22 to 2023-24). State/UT-wise details are given in **Annexure-I**.
- (c): The KVKs have formed 709 Farm Science Clubs as one of extension activities to promote new technologies in agriculture and allied sectors. However, 100 KVKs of the country are implementing project namely Attracting and Retaining Youth in Agriculture (ARYA) for retaining younger generations of farming families into the sector. These KVKs organize skill development programmes for the youth of rural areas to take up various enterprises related to agriculture and allied sectors like, mushroom production, fruits and vegetable processing units, horticulture nursery, protected cultivation, fish farming, poultry, goat farming, piggery, duck farming, bee keeping, vermicomposting, etc.
- (d): The KVKs organize various extension programmes to develop awareness of improved agricultural technology among the farmers nationwide. In all, 605.02 lakh beneficiaries participated in the extension activities during last 3 years. Activity wise details of participants in the extension activities during last 3 years are given in **Annexure-II**.

(e): Rythu Bharosa Kendram is a Scheme of State Government of Andhra Pradesh for providing one-stop solution to farmers' needs like supply of pre-tested agriculture inputs, delivery of services, capacity building and knowledge dissemination. Agriculture being the state subject, state governments implement different schemes for the benefit of farmers and agriculture development. Government of India also implements various schemes for the development of agriculture sector and the benefits of farmers such as PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi, Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana, Soil Health Card Scheme, Agri-Clinics & Agri-Business Centres, National Mission on Natural Farming, PM Krishi Sinchayee Yojana, KVK Scheme, etc. and considers the various initiatives and best practices of the State Governments in formulating various schemes.
