**INCREASE IN IMPORT DUTY TO SUPPORT OILSEED FARMERS**

2438. SMT. PHULO DEVI NETAM:

Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has recently increased import duty on vegetable oils to support domestic oilseed farmers;
- (b) if so, the details of these changes and their expected impact on domestic oilseed prices and farmer incomes;
- (c) year-wise data on import volumes, import duties, and revenue collected from crude and refined vegetable oils over the past five years; and
- (d) Minimum Support Price (MSP), market prices, and procurement data for soybean and rapeseed over the last five years, along with projections post-import duty revision?

**ANSWER**

**(a) & (b)** In order to support the oilseeds farmers, the Basic Custom Duty on Crude Soybean Oil, Crude Palm Oil, and Crude Sunflower Oil was raised from 0% to 20%, making the effective duty on crude oils to 27.5% and the Basic Custom Duty on Refined Palm Oil, Refined Sunflower Oil, and Refined Soybean Oil was increased from 12.5% to 32.5% making the effective duty on Refined oils as 35.75% w.e.f 14<sup>th</sup> September 2024. These adjustments are part of the government's ongoing efforts to bolster domestic oilseed production.

**(c)** The data (oil year-wise) of import volumes of Crude and refined vegetable oils over the past five years is as under:
