SUPPORT TO TELANGANA'S SEMICONDUCTOR MISSION

- (a) whether Government has taken any steps regarding the request received from Telangana to provide financial and technical support in establishing a Semiconductor Mission in that State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): Government has approved Semicon India programme with a total outlay of Rs 76,000 crore for the development of semiconductor and display manufacturing ecosystem in the country. It does not have any provision for setting up of Semiconductor Missions in any State. States are free to setup their own semiconductor Missions.
