STATUS OF SAWANTWADI TERMINUS PROJECT

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of the Sawantwadi Terminus project, whose foundation stone was laid in 2015;
- (b) the reasons for the delay in the completion of this terminus despite its importance to the Konkan region;
- (c) the amount of funding which has been allocated to Sawantwadi Terminus since its foundation stone was laid and the amount which has been utilized; and
- (d) whether it is a fact that funds allocated for this project were returned due to underutilization, if so, corrective measures being taken to address this issue?

(a) to (d): The work of providing additional facilities and passenger terminal at Sawantwadi Road Station was sanctioned at a total cost of Rs. 19.57 Cr. The work of construction of terminal line/stabling line, siding, foot over bridge, High level platform, Platform shelter, Extension of bridges and other associated works have already been completed and expenditure of Rs. 13.58 Cr has been incurred so far. After completion of the above work, two trains, namely, Sawantwadi - Dadar Tutari Express and Sawantwadi - Diva Express apart from Holiday Specials originate from Sawantwadi Road Station.
