#### NUMBER OF ROADS SANCTIONED FOR CONSTRUCTION IN ODISHA UNDER PMGSY

#### 2531 DR. SASMIT PATRA:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of roads sanctioned for construction in Odisha under the Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY) since its launch in 2000;
- (b) the number of roads sanctioned and completed in each district of Odisha since 2000;
- (c) whether any budget is released by the Union Government for the maintenance of these roads; and
- (d) if so, the amount of budget released for the maintenance of roads in different districts of Odisha?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

- (a) & (b): Since the launch of Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY), as on 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2025, a total of 17,885 roads of 74,133 km length and 703 bridges have been sanctioned under the scheme in the State of Odisha, out of which 17,503 roads of 70,405 km length and 626 bridges have already been constructed. The number of roads sanctioned and completed in each district of Odisha since 2000 is given at **Annexure**.
- (c) & (d): "Rural road" is a State subject. Maintenance of roads constructed under the programme is the responsibility of the State Governments and all road works are covered by initial five year maintenance contracts to be entered into along with the construction contract, with the same contractor, as per the Standard Bidding Document. Maintenance funds are to be provided by the State Government. Maintenance of roads beyond 5 years is also to be done by the State Government.

Since 2016-17, financial incentives are being given to States/ UTs showing better performance under PMGSY. These funds are to be used by the States for renewal of PMGSY roads after 5 year Defect Liability Period (DLP). The State of Odisha was given financial incentive fund during the years 2016-17 to 2023-24 as given below:-
