SETTING UP OF TEXTILE PARK IN PUNJAB UNDER PM-MITRA

2559. SHRI RAGHAV CHADHA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is planning to set-up a textile park in the state of Punjab under the PM-MITRA scheme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Ministry has given any assurance to the Punjab Government about setting up a textile park in the State, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the reasons for the delay in the establishment of the textile park if the options for the land have already been given by the State to the Union Government?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR TEXTILES (SHRI PABITRA MARGHERITA)

(a) to (d): With a view to develop integrated large scale and modern industrial infrastructure facility for the entire value-chain of the textile industry, the Government has approved setting up of 7 (Seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with a scheme outlay of Rs. 4,445 crore for the period 2021-22 to 2027-28.

All States including Punjab were requested to submit proposal(s) under scheme guidelines for setting up of PM MITRA Park in respective States. In response, 18 proposals from 13 State Governments including one from Punjab (Ludhiana) were received within the stipulated deadline. The proposal from Punjab was later withdrawn by the Government of Punjab.

The Government has finalised 7 sites viz. Tamil Nadu (Virudhnagar), Telangana (Warangal), Gujarat (Navsari), Karnataka (Kalaburagi), Madhya Pradesh (Dhar), Uttar Pradesh (Lucknow) and Maharashtra (Amravati) for setting up PM MITRA Parks. There is no proposal currently pending in the Ministry for establishment of Textile Park in Punjab.
