NEXT PHASE OF SMART CITIES MISSION

2617. SHRI MANOJ KUMAR JHA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government plans to launch the next phase of the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) covering more cities, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether a third-party assessment of projects implemented under the SCM has been conducted, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the expertise of Special Purpose Vehicles (SPVs) will be utilized in other urban development initiatives; and
- (d) the steps taken by Government to improve city planning, governance, and infrastructure through the SCM?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

- (a) No, on the requests received from the States/ UTs, Government of India has extended the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) up to 31.03.2025 for completion of its ongoing projects.
- (b) A mid-term evaluation study was undertaken by 'NITI Aayog' for 'Evaluation of Centrally Sponsored Schemes in Urban Transformation Sector'. As part of the study, SCM was evaluated and the report was published in February 2021. Recently, NITI Aayog has initiated a Third Party Assessment of the Mission which has already begun.
- (c) As per Mission guidelines, the Special Purpose Vehicles (SPVs) of the smart cities are responsible for the design, implementation and operation of smart city projects at the City level. These SPVs are jointly owned by the State/UT and Urban Local Bodies (ULBs), with equal shareholding. State Governments/ UT Administration may decide whether the expertise of SPVs will be utilized in other urban development initiatives.
- (d) Cities under SCM are being developed based on Smart City Proposals (SCPs) across various sectors viz. smart mobility, Water, Sanitation, Hygiene (WASH), smart governance, smart energy, environment etc., approved by High Powered Steering Committee (HPSC), received from States/UTs. As on 04.03.2025, under SCM, of a total 8,063 projects amounting to ₹1,64,545 crore, 7,504 projects (i.e. 93% of total projects) amounting to ₹1,50,306 crore have been completed, as per the data provided by cities. The sector wise details of projects are at Annexure.
