FLOOD MANAGEMENT SYSTEM IN THE COUNTRY

Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

- (a) details regarding the list of proposals received, approved, under construction and presently functioning regarding flood control and management during the last five years, State-wise and in the State of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) total funds allocated, sanctioned and utilised, project-wise, during the last five years across the country;
- (c) whether Government is providing grant-in-aid to States/UTs for riverbank degradation due to floods and anti-erosion works; and
- (d) if so, the details regarding the works undertaken for the same during the last five years, State-wise and in the State of Andhra Pradesh?

(a) The details of flood/erosion management schemes/proposals received in the last five years for the purpose of techno-economic appraisal is given in **Annexure-I**. No flood control and management projects have been received from the state of Andhra Pradesh over the last five years in Central Water Commission (CWC).

(b) to (d) Flood management and anti-erosion schemes are formulated and implemented by concerned State Governments as per their priority. The Union Government supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical guidance and promotional financial assistance for the management of floods in critical areas.

To strengthen the structural measures of flood management, Ministry had implemented during XI & XII Plan Flood Management Programme (FMP) for providing Central Assistance to States for works related to river management, flood control, anti-erosion, drainage development, anti-sea erosion, flood proofing, catchment area treatment etc. which subsequently continued as a component of "Flood Management and Border Areas Programme" (FMBAP) for the period from 2017-18 to 2020-21 and further extended upto March, 2026.

Central Assistance released under Flood Management and Border Areas Programme (FMBAP) during last 5 years to States/UTs is Rs. 1056 Crore. State-wise details is in **Annexure-II**.
