"Establishment of All India Ayurveda Institute"

Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) the expected timeline for the establishment of All India Ayurveda Institute and 11 other ayurvedic colleges;
- (b) the priority research areas that the All India Ayurveda Institute aims to explore;
- (c) the manner in which the institute will contribute to the growth of Ayurveda in India and globally; and
- (d) whether the institute will collaborate with international Ayurveda or alternative medicine organizations?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (I/C) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) to (d) There is no proposal under consideration to establish new All India Ayurveda Institute and 11 other ayurvedic colleges. However, an All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA), under the Ministry of Ayush is operational at New Delhi. Further, a Satellite Centre of AIIA, New Delhi has been established in Goa.
