- (a) whether USAID, through its various health projects in India, such as maternal and child health programs, infectious disease control, and health system strengthening initiatives, has collected any sensitive health data of Indian citizens;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with measures taken to ensure data security;
- (c) whether Government has taken any steps to prevent potential misuse of healthrelated information collected by USAID or other foreign organizations involved in health initiatives; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): No, Government's collaborations with various international organizations are governed by data security measures as per Government's existing policies.
